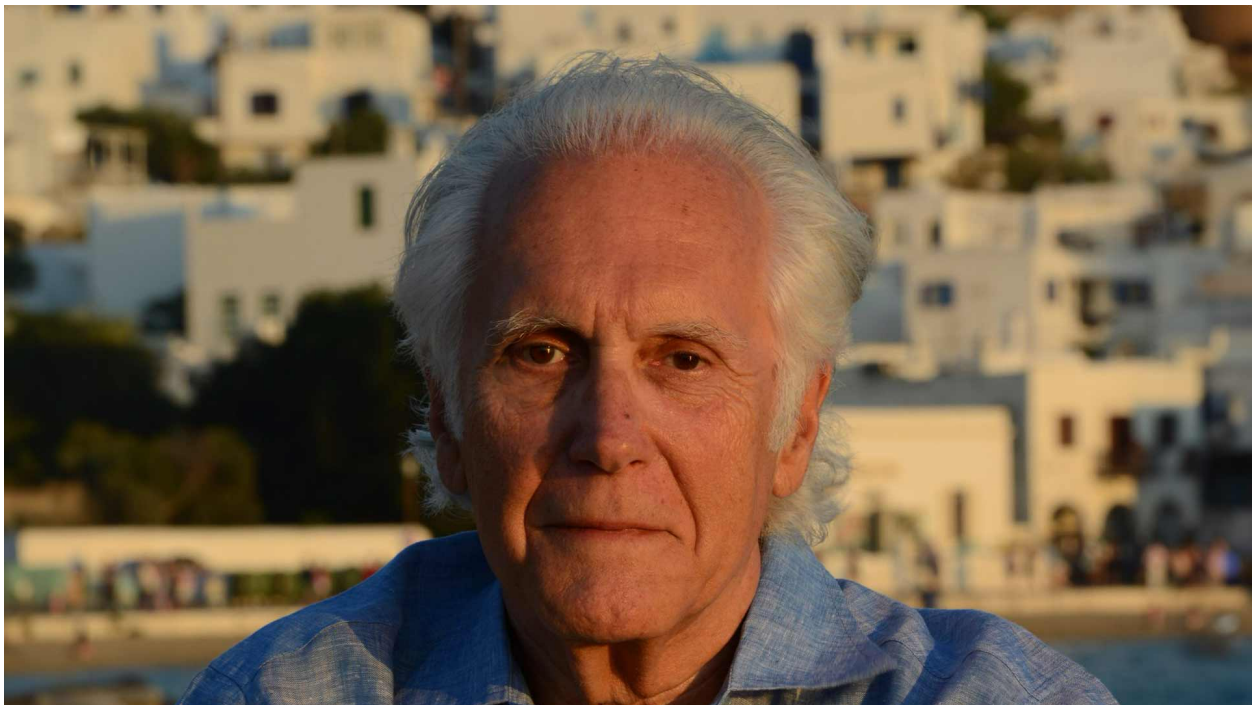

Severn House scoops first 12 books in Jeffrey Siger's mystery series

Severn House has acquired world English rights to books one through 12 in Jeffrey Siger's bestselling Andreas Kaldis mystery series. Severn House (an imprint of **Canongate Books**) is planning to re-release all 12 books in the series in paperback and e-book, starting in November 2025, to coincide with the release of the 14th book in the series, *Not Dead Yet*, in paperback.

The Andreas Kaldis mysteries are set in **Greece**, primarily on the islands in the Cyclades, and have attracted praise for the depiction of Greek life, culture and politics.

Siger, a former Wall Street lawyer who now lives on the island of Mykonos, has been honoured by the Greek government as “the only American author writing novels serving as a guide to Greece”. The rights to the series were previously owned by **Poisoned Pen Press**, but the 13th book in the mysteries series (*At Any Cost*) was published with Severn House.

Publisher at Severn House Joanna Grant said: “Since welcoming the Andreas Kaldis mysteries to Severn House in 2024 with *At Any Cost* – the 13th book in the series – we’ve built a fantastic relationship with both Jeff and his dedicated fans. I am absolutely thrilled to bring this much-loved series under one roof, and we look forward to bringing more new readers to this sun-soaked Greek mystery series.”

Editorial director at Severn House and editor for Siger Rachel Slatter said: “The Inspector Andreas Kaldis mysteries are something special – an amazing blend of characters you’ll want to get to know, red-herring-packed mysteries and page-turning suspense, set against a Greek backdrop that’s both gritty and appealing. I can’t wait for more readers to fall in love with this series in the way I have.”

Siger said: “I have been delighted to continue Kaldis’ adventures with Severn House and so it’s a real thrill to be able to move the full series to its new home. It’s a pleasure to work with such an enthusiastic and talented team, and I’m very excited for the books to hit the shelves later this year.”
